What is the Alberta Electronic Waste Recycling Program?

Alberta's Electronics Recycling Program, a first of its kind in Canada, helps alleviate the challenges associated with handling the growing volume of electronic waste, which may contain toxic components and shouldn't be disposed of in landfill sites. The program has been structured along the same vein as Alberta's tire and used oil recycling program. Under Alberta's program, Albertans can now recycle select electronic equipment with a provincially approved vendor at **NO CHARGE**.

How does the program work?

1. Provincially audited and approved processors are paid by the Alberta Recycling Management Authority (ARMA), an arms length, government appointed body responsible for all recycling programs in Alberta (www.albertarecycling.ca).
2. Approved processors are paid a per tonne rate based on the amount of equipment they have processed. Approved processors are not paid until they have shown the equipment has been properly recycled.
3. Approved processors have been audited to ensure strict environmental and H&S compliance and are audited on an ongoing basis to ensure they are maintaining the standard.
4. Processors who are not approved by ARMA have not been audited, or have failed their audits and are not participants in the provincial program.
5. Non-approved processors receive no program funds and have not been checked to ensure proper recycling, environmental compliance, data security or H&S standards.
